



Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Minimum Allotments

The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, signed by President Donald J. Trump on December 27, 2020, increases Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits by raising maximum allotments to 115 percent of the June 2020 value of the Thrifty Food Plan (TFP).

The following tables provide the monthly minimum allotment for FY 2021 (effective January 1, 2021, through June 30, 2021).
