*FNS's preliminary data also shows that some States are incorrectly combining PEBT and SNAP participation and issuance in their monthly reporting to the Agency. FNS is currently working with its State partners to clarify reporting guidance for PEBT to correct these reporting issues. This will include requiring States to revise prior month reporting to correct errors as appropriate.
