




Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) Household Composition

Of the FDPIR households served, **48%** had only 1 member, while **20%** had 2 members, **13%** had 3 members, and nearly **10%** had 4 members. The remaining **9%** of households had 5 or more members.



Nearly **1 in 3** FDPIR households has children under the age of **18**.

About **2 in 5** FDPIR households have elderly members with **41%** of all FDPIR households including adults aged **60** or older and **29%** having only elderly members. Most of these elders (**85%**) live alone, and **15%** live with another elder.



Most heads of all FDPIR households (**77%**) identified as being **single**.



Most FDPIR households are headed by women.

Approximately 2/3 of the household heads participating in FDPIR are **women (62%)** and more than 1/3 are men (38%). Of all of the participants, **54% are female** and 46% are male.
